Measurements required: All measurements should be taken with a normal and comfortable posture. Ideally ask somebody with experience in menswear (a sales consultant in your area).

1. Neck/Shirt: Measurement taken at the base of the neck, with two fingers between the neck and tape measure.

2. Chest/Jacket Size: Measure from under the arms following the same line through the back and finish at the chest. Make the tape quiet firm. Alternatively if you own a suit that fits well, look in jacket for a size label.

3. Outside Sleeve: Measure from the top of the sleeve where it meets the shoulder pad, and follow the middle of the sleeve down to its desired length. Ensure your arm is straight down by your side, and if wearing a French cuff shirt allow for the cuff to be visible.

4. Waist/Trouser: A firm measurement where the waistband of a suit trouser normally sits. (Jeans/Casual trousers sit a little lower) Alternatively if you own a suit that fits well, look in trouser for a size label.

5. Outside Leg: A measurement from the top of the waistband of a suit trouser following the outside seam, to the top of the heel of your shoe. If you are not wearing a dress shoe stand barefoot and simply measure to the floor.
